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# INTRODUCTION


This product descriptions catalog is a reference guide designed to provide you with details on the products and services (and their support materials, if any) published/offered by Christian Liberty Press. It is similar in scope to the *Christian Liberty Press Product Catalog*, except that it provides additional details on each of the items. Only those items whose primary products are published by Christian Liberty Press are listed; support materials created for third-party products (such as an answer key or test packet for a Bob Jones publication) are not included.

This guide is broken down into several sections, each of which focuses on a specific academic theme or area of study. They are listed in alphabetical order and are as follows:

Art and Music	Economics, Government, and History	Mathematics	Science
Bible, Commentaries, and Theology	Fiction	Multi-Discipline	Services
Biographies	Language Arts	Phonics and Readers	Support Materials

Within each of the above subject areas, the individual products are listed by grade level, starting with pre-school (or the lowest level available) and progressing through high school. Where multiple products exist for a particular grade level, or if grade level is irrelevant, then those products are listed in alphabetical order (unless those items are part of a series).

The header on each page identifies the specific details for the products listed and are defined as follows:

- Product Title ..... The title of the product as listed on the cover, or the service.
- Author(s) ..... The author(s), or in the case of compilations or collaborative works, editor(s) of the product.
- Grade Lvl ..... The grade level range for which the product is best suited.
- Age Lvl ..... The age level range for which the product is best suited.
- Copyright © ..... The most recent copyright date of the product as listed in the product.
- Edition ..... The most recent edition of the product. Note: The edition and/or copyright will not change if only minor changes are made to a product.
- Product Item ..... Identifies what the product is, whether it be a textbook, workbook, test packet, answer key, etc. The description “book” is used if the item is does not have review questions or other activities associated with a text.
- Print Color ..... Identifies the color method used for the inside material of the product. Options include b/w (black and white), 2-color, and full color.
- Binding ..... Identifies how the product is bound. Books are usually hardbound or softbound (saddle-stitch and comb bindings are specifically identified). Many of the keys and test materials are side-stapled or corner-stapled. eBook products are also identified here as to their type (currently either PDF eBook or ePub) and include the  symbol. CD and CD-ROM materials are identified by how they are packaged.
- Details ..... In most cases, the number of pages in the product is given (test packets show number of tests plus whether they have a test key with them); audio products list either the total run time or number of tracks. For printed products, the page number shown is the number one would find by turning to the last page of the book (i.e., front matter is not usually calculated in the page count). PDF eBooks, on the other hand, derive their page count from the total number of pages in the file (which will include front matter, cover, and any other pages included in the electronic document). ePub products do not have a page count because of the reflowing text.
- SKU ..... The product identification number used by Christian Liberty Press. In the product and retail catalogs, this number will be preceded by the letters “CLP.”
- ISBN ..... The 13-digit ISBN code given to the product by Christian Liberty Press. If the number is in italics, then the ISBN and/or barcode does not currently appear on the product.
- Product Description .. A brief description of the product and each of the ancillary items associated with that product. Specific notes related to the product are also included.
