Introduction

This test packet is provided by Christian Liberty Press to help instructors measure how well their students have understood the material in *God and Government: Volume 2*. It includes ten tests and a test key. Each test covers one lesson and consists of twenty questions per test. The tests use a mixture of true-false, multiple choice, and matching questions. Each test should be completed at the end of the respective lesson being tested, following the test schedule found below.

The test answer key is separated from the tests by a divider. The test key is provided to help instructors to evaluate their students' performance. **Students must not have any direct or indirect access to the test key.** Any student access to the test key invalidates a given test or set of tests as a measure of student performance.

Before You Begin

Place this file (and all copies if you have already printed these pages) in a location that is not accessible to students. Students should not have access to any test prior to test time. Students should never have access to the test key.

We encourage you to summarize this introduction to your students before starting the course so that they will be adequately prepared for taking these tests.

Test Preparation

Students should carefully review the pages covered on a test and study their answers to the "Questions for Discussion" prior to taking a test. Although questions on the tests may not come directly from the written daily work exercises, the comprehension, concepts, and skills required in the daily work will be helpful when taking the tests.

Test Completion

When completing the tests, students may not have access to the textbook or to their completed written daily work. Also, they may not make use of the test key. All direct or indirect student access to the test key is a violation of accepted academic principles. Tests that reflect student access to this information cannot be considered to be a true measure of student performance.
