

Introduction

The Christian Liberty Preschool Drill Book reinforces basic handwriting skills, printing the twenty-six letters of the alphabet, writing counting numbers 0 through 10 in sequence (including drill sheets on printing the numbers 11 to 20), and drawing with shapes and colors. These drill sheets are designed to be used with what is being taught in the Christian Liberty Preschool Activity Book. Instructors are encouraged to be sensitive to the individual capabilities of each of their students, especially in the area of handwriting development. Therefore, you have permission to copy any of the drill sheets in this drill book to give your students the extra practice they may need.

The drill sheets should be utilized in correspondence with the lessons in the *Christian Liberty Preschool Activity Book*. For example, when teaching your students how to draw circles (i.e., pages 5, 9, 11, and 19 in the *Activity Book*), use the drill sheets on pages 7 and 8 for practice. Also, when teaching your students how to cross out a picture (i.e., pages 13 and 19 in the *Activity Book*), use the drill sheet on page 16 for practice. In addition, there are certificates of completion on page 57 to reward students who have successfully finished this drill book.

The drill sheets contained in the *Christian Liberty Preschool Drill Book* have been successfully used in the Christian Liberty Academy day school for a number of years. Much of the material has been developed with the help of many ideas obtained from teachers and other resources. We hope this time-tested material will enhance your efforts as a teacher.


