First Catechism

84. Q. *What is the first commandment?*
A. The first commandment is "You shall have no other gods before Me." (*NKJV*)
85. Q. *What does the first commandment teach you?*
A. To worship the true God, and him only.

86. Q. *What is the second commandment?*
A. The second commandment is "You shall not make for yourself a carved image—any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth; you shall not bow down to them nor serve them. For I, the LORD your God, am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children to the third and fourth generations of those who hate Me, but showing mercy to thousands, to those who love Me and keep My commandments." (*NKJV*)
87. Q. *What does the second commandment teach you?*
A. To worship God only as he commands, and not to worship God by using statues or pictures.
88. Q. *What is the third commandment?*
A. The third commandment is "You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain, for the LORD will not hold him guiltless who takes His name in vain." (*NKJV*)
89. Q. *What does the third commandment teach you?*
A. To treat God's name, word and works with reverence.
90. Q. *What is the fourth commandment?*
A. The fourth commandment is "Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy. Six days you shall labor and do all your work, but the seventh day is the Sabbath of the LORD your God. In it you shall do no work: you, nor your son, nor your daughter, nor your male servant, nor your female servant, nor your cattle, nor your stranger who is within your gates. For in six days the LORD made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them, and rested the seventh day. Therefore the LORD blessed the Sabbath day and hallowed it." (*NKJV*)
91. Q. *What does the fourth commandment teach you?*
A. To work six days and keep the Sabbath day holy.
