WRITER'S GUIDELINES

Christian Liberty Press (CLP) is the publishing arm of the nationally recognized Christian Liberty Academy and Christian Liberty Homeschools (CLH). As a ministry of the Church of Christian Liberty, CLP is dedicated to publishing works that are consistent with the Word of God. We are rooted in the Reformed tradition, as expressed in the Westminster Confession of Faith.

The mission of CLP is to assist parents in the noble task of educating students for the glory of God. We focus our publishing efforts on curriculum for preschool through high school. We also produce a variety of enrichment and support books, including Christian and historical fiction, biographies, education resources, and Bible study materials.

Christian Liberty Press welcomes submissions that are consistent with both the worldview and mission of our publishing ministry. Our consideration of potential projects is in two stages: initial proposal and manuscript.

INITIAL PROPOSAL

The author or editor should submit an initial proposal first, rather than sending a complete manuscript. The initial proposal must include the following information:

- the suggested title of the proposed text, the estimated number of pages, the purpose of the project, the potential use and market for the book, and the strengths of the product in comparison to similar items currently available.
- an outline of the manuscript and two sample chapters.
- background information on the author or editor of the project. This would include name, contact information, education, previous writing experience, and employment history.

The required material for an initial proposal may be sent either electronically or by mail. Christian Liberty Press will typically take between one and three months to evaluate an initial proposal and contact the author.

MANUSCRIPT

If Christian Liberty Press is interested in the proposal, we will contact the author to encourage him or her to complete the manuscript of their project. We generally will not issue a contract for a project until the manuscript is finished and we have had a chance to review the completed work.

The manuscript must be sent to Christian Liberty Press both electronically and in printed form.
